

Lyrics Window for Dorico

This uses AutoHotKey to enable the pasting of lyrics into Dorico. You must either have AutoHotKey installed on your computer or else run the .exe version. You must also, of course, have Dorico.

It only works for Windows computers and It does NOT hyphenate lyrics. To do this you could visit Juicio Brennan's website.



To us it:

Enter the notes first, select the first note and then run the script.

Once you have finished, make sure that the window is closed, otherwise Dorico will not function correctly. You can exit anytime by pressing **Esc** or closing the window.



Click here to paste all the syllables at once. If a syllable is intended for more than one note it must be followed by the correct number of spaces or hyphens.

! Pressing Consolidate Text after adding these will remove them.

This removes double hyphens, double spaces and extra linefeeds from the text. It should be used BEFORE adding the extra spaces and hyphens required to paste all syllable at once.

Click here to paste one syllable at a time. Use the Alt key to add the syllables and these can be extended the normal way by pressing the space bar or a hyphen.

This controls the time given to Dorico to respond to the script. It should be increased if the script does not function correctly. Faster speeds require faster computers.

! Faster speeds = lower numbers.
